1. **VARIANCE REQUEST BY WEXFORD COURT HOMEOWNER'S ASSOCIATION (220 CELESTIAL WAY)**

Bob Hamilton, Applicant, 220 Celestial Way #6, gave more detailed information about the application, expressed his concerns and asked for approval from the Council. He also asked the Town Council if they had any questions.

Vice Mayor Pro Tem Fahy asked how they settled on a height of 6 feet.

Bob Hamilton stated that the Town Code limits the height to 4 feet, which is easy to scale. They decided to go lower than Cote de la Mer, but higher than Beachbound.

G. Council Motion



H. Council Action


The motion passed 4-0.
