Ms. Dobbins stated that the rates will increase slightly in 2016, with a \$10/hour increase for Principal Engineers and an increase of \$5/hour for Senior Engineers/Senior Technicians.

Councilmember Lyons stated that this Saturday is the Treasures of Juno Beach Event at Oceanview United Methodist Church from 8 am to 1 pm.


Vice Mayor Pro Tem Greene stated that he would like the Juno Beach Employee Contact list emailed to Council in excel format.

Town Manager Lo Bello stated that he would have staff do this.


