

NOMINATION PROCEDURE

Mayor

The Town Attorney opens nominations for office of Mayor.

Members of the Town Council make nominations (nominations do not require a second, member may decline a nomination).

The Town Attorney closes nominations.

The Town Clerk calls for a roll call vote and each Council member casts his or her vote in favor of one of the nominees. The person receiving a majority of the votes is elected to the position. *If there are three nominees and one nominee does not receive a majority, the members of the Town Council shall choose between the two members who received the highest number of votes.*

Vice-Mayor

The Mayor opens nominations for office of Vice Mayor.

Members of the Town Council make nominations (nominations do not require a second, member may decline a nomination).

The Mayor closes nominations.

The Town Clerk calls for a roll call vote and each Council member casts his or her vote in favor of one of the nominees. The person receiving a majority of the votes is elected to the position. *If there are three nominees and one member does not receive a majority, the members of the Town Council shall choose between the two members who received the highest number of votes.*

Vice Mayor Pro Tem

Same procedure utilized for Vice Mayor.
