

Town of Juno Beach Police Department Position Requirements & Information Summary

Title: Police Officer
Annual Wage: \$52,261.75 (based on 84 hour work period) - possible incentive for extensive experience

Duties: Performs general police work in the protection of life and property through the enforcement of laws and ordinances.

Requirements: All applicants must:

Be of good moral character pursuant to the Florida Department of Law Enforcement, (FDLE) with no felony convictions. No misdemeanor convictions involving "moral turpitude".

Possess a high school diploma or equivalent, General Education Diploma (GED). Graduation from the United States Armed Forces Institute (USAFI) is acceptable when accompanied by a certified or official transcript of grades. An out-of-state General Education Diploma (GED) or the USAFI equivalency must be acceptable by the State of Florida Police Standards Council.

Military applicants must present proof of honorable discharge or release.

Be a U.S. citizen. Be at least twenty one (21) years of age.

Possess a valid driver's license from any U.S. state at time of application provided, prior to appointment, a valid State of Florida Class E, or higher, Driver License is obtained. Safe driving record.

Have a State of Florida Basic Law Enforcement Certification in good standing or out-of-state certified officers and federal officers must have at least one (1) complete year of full time police experience (must have passed the probationary time) and must meet the minimum requirements governed by the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) to determine training exemptions and an Equivalency of Training.

Two (2) years of law enforcement experience, completion of 60 college credits from an accredited college or university, is preferred, or an equivalent combination of education and experience.

Vision: binocular and monocular vision of 20/100 uncorrected and 20/30 or better corrected. Have color vision.

Complete all requirements established by the Juno Beach Police Department.

Selection:

Applicants must pass the following, including but limited to: an Application Review, Panel Review, Oral interview(s), Computer voice stress analysis (CVSA), Psychological test(s) and interview, Medical examination, Background investigation.
