4. DISCUSS PROJECT RECEPTION/UNVEILING EVENT AND DATE

The Committee discussed the Celestial Railroad rails and display options.

The Committee gave consensus to have the Juno Beach Historical Society take over the rail project, with two guidelines: preservation and accessibility of at least one of the train rails/spikes.

The Committee gave consensus that they will turn over all future projects over to the JBHS.
