1. **DISCUSSION ON LONG TERM VISION FOR PELICAN LAKE**

Jim Ferguson, 391 Sunrise Way, shared a Power Point presentation about the history and ecology of Pelican Lake (*see attached*) as well as submitted some examples of a long-term vision for Pelican Lake (*see attached*).

2. **DISCUSSION ON FLORIDA FISH & WILDLIFE (FWC) GRANT**

DD Halpern, 410 Apollo Drive, spoke on behalf of the Ecology Group about Florida Fish & Wildlife Conservation (FWC) grant options for Pelican Lake.

Workshop attendees discussed this matter.

Town Manager Lo Bello and Ms. Halpern formed a sub-committee to reach out to FWC to discuss the grants, fish count and analysis options.

3. **DISCUSSION ON TYPES OF WATER TESTING**

Diana Davis, 440 Sunset Way, spoke on behalf of the Ecology Group and read their vision statement.

Bob Weigt, Hobe Sound Environmental (*via Zoom*), explained the process for testing water quality.

Director of Public Works Meriano and resident Diana Davis formed a sub-committee to review and recommend water testing options and then consult with Mr. Weigt from Hobe Sound Environmental.

4. **DISCUSSION ON PROCESS FOR CREATING A SHORT AND LONG TERM MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR PELICAN LAKE**

Mr. Ferguson stated that he would like to invite FWC and Shawn Patton from Stocking Savvy to explain their views for the lake.

Workshop attendees discussed this matter.

Mr. Weigt offered to send his biologist to take depth measurements of the lake at no charge to the Town.

Town Manager Lo Bello agreed and stated that staff will set a time to conduct a tour of Pelican Lake and anyone who is interested can attend.
