## **ORDINANCE NO. 758**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JUNO BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2021 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2022; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, CONFLICTS AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

**WHEREAS**, Town Staff has determined that in accordance with applicable accounting principles, and as required by state law, the Town must amend the annual budget for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 2021 and ending September 30, 2022 ("Fiscal Year 2021-2022"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council wishes to amend the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 budget to provide for certain adjustments and amendments thereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JUNO BEACH, FLORIDA, as follows:

**Section 1.** The foregoing recitals are ratified as true and incorporated herein.

**Section 2**. The Town Council hereby approves the following budget adjustments as an official amendment to the original budget for Fiscal Year 2021-2022, as adopted on September 22, 2021:
