Trespassing Enforcement Affidavit

Pursuant to F.S.S. 810.08, whoever without being authorized, licensed, or invited willfully enters or remains in any structure or conveyance, or, having been authorized, licensed, or invited, is warned by the owner or lessee of the premises, or by a person authorized by the owner or lessee, to depart and refuses to do so, commits the offense of trespass in a structure or conveyance.

Pursuant to F.S. S. 810.09, whoever without being authorized, licensed or invited willfully enters upon or remain in any property other than a structure or conveyance as to which notice against entering or remaining is given, either by actual communication to the offender or by posting, fencing, or cultivation as described in F.S. S. 810.0117 commits the offense of trespass on property other than a structure or conveyance.

If the offender defies an order to leave, personally communicated to him, by the owner of the premises or by an authorized person, he/she commits the offense of trespassing, a misdemeanor punishable as provided in F.S. S. 775.082 or F.S.S. 775.083.

This document is to serve notice that officers of Juno Beach Police Department are authorized by the owner or agent of the below listed property to enforce trespassing statutes on said property, including parking lots. As authorized representatives, officers of the Juno Beach Police Department may enforce the State of Florida trespassing statutes by warning and directing undesired persons to leave the property and/or cartilage thereof. The owner or agent of the below listed property located in the Town of Juno Beach, Palm Beach County, Florida, agrees that he/she/they will aid in the prosecution of those persons arrested.

This enforcement authorization will be valid until: sale, change of ownership, or dissolution of business, or upon the owner/agent's request to cancel the designation of Juno Beach Police Officers as its authorized representative. If any event occurs, it is the responsibility of the owner/agent to notify the Juno Beach Police Department. Any notice required or any changes to the information below must immediately be reported to 561-626-2100.
